Congratulations to Louisiana as the 21st SAMHSA/SCLC Leadership Academy State!

The National Center of Excellence for Tobacco Free-Recovery is excited to announce Louisiana as the 21st Leadership Academy State. The summit will be held May 27-28, 2020 in Baton Rouge. The goal of the Leadership Academies is to create a state-wide collaboration among mental health substance use treatment, tobacco control, and public health departments, charged to produce an action plan to reduce smoking prevalence of behavioral health consumers and staff and to foster tobacco-free living.

With progressive policy changes like the New Orleans Smoke-Free Ordinance and strong cessation services like the Louisiana quitline, we look forward to seeing what other strategies this new group of stakeholders develops to combat the epidemic of tobacco use in the behavioral health community.

Pennsylvania State Academy Reconvening

In July 2020, a reconvening will be held in Pennsylvania to continue the work from the previous State Leadership Academy held in 2017. Since the summit, Pennsylvania has reduced the smoking rate of adults with poor mental health from 37.4% to 35.1%.

Here are a few highlights about Pennsylvania since its 2017 summit:

• As of December 31, 2018, all state hospitals have implemented policies for smoke-free campuses

- All Physical Health and Behavioral Health MCOs have submitted action plans related to comprehensive tobacco cessation programs targeting plan employees, outpatient treatment facilities, and members (clients)
- Cessation trainings for pharmacists have been implemented, including option to enroll as a Medicaid tobacco cessation provider
- There has been a significant increase in communications between and among the MCOs, Department of Health, Department of Drug and Alcohol, and Department of Human Services/Office on Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services resulting in uniform messaging, increased engagement and utilization of existing DOH resources
